Day of Prayer for Victims of Trafficking

This Sunday we pray for the Victims of Trafficking and Slavery and for their rescue. We celebrate the Feast of St Josephine Bakita, a Sudanese woman who was canonised by Pope St John Paul II in 2000. She was sold into slavery, rescued and then became a nun in Italy.

The number of enslaved souls currently estimated to be living all around East Anglia is 5,000. Pope Francis wanted us to "find" enslaved people. All that means is learning (simply) to spot the signs and safely report any concerns to the Modern Slavery Helpline 08000 121 700.
